

Announcement of Mahidol University The Closure of Mahidol University (Kanchanaburi Campus) and the Use of Online System for Academic Activities and Meetings

Reference is made to the Announcement of Mahidol University on the Closure of Mahidol University Salaya Campus dated the 23rd December 2020 and the Announcement on Working from Home for University Personnel and the Use of Online System for Academic Activities and Meetings in Phyathai, Bangkok Noi and Campuses in Provincial Areas dated the 28th December 2020, to limit the spread of the Coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19).

Mahidol University would like to further announce an additional closure in Kanchanaburi Campus due to a report of an infected case of COVID-19 within the campus. <u>The closure of</u> <u>Kanchanaburi Campus will be starting from the 31st December 2020 until further notice</u>. Staff and students of Mahidol University Kanchanaburi Campus are requested to observe the followings:

- All academic and supporting staff are advised to work from home, except the units responsible for security/safety/ other physical maintenance units. Vice President responsible for Kanchanaburi Campus is to supervise and monitor workloads as seen appropriate in order to ensure the efficiency and the continuity of the workplace.
- 2) All Teaching and learning, final examinations, other academic activities, university or faculty meetings in the campus are to be convened using the online system.
- 3) All staff members and students are advised to follow measures suggested by the Department of Disease Control, Ministry of Public Health, including, distancing protocols, mask wearing, hand washing, temperature checking and using Morchana application throughout the campus. Provided that any staff or students have any

suspected symptoms or questions, please contact Mr. Krish Kaobang, Advisor to the Vice President, Kanchanaburi Campus, via Tel: 089-893-1109.

4) Mahidol University Kanchanaburi Campus has already followed the standard measures and protocols of the Department of Disease Control, Ministry of Public Health, by fuming all suspected venues with disinfectants, separate close contacts with high risks from the rest, provide psychological services by certified professionals, garbage sorting, and provide necessary equipment such as thermometers and alcohol gel available throughout the campus.
