



## Announcement of Mahidol University

### On Document Certification for Mahidol University Personnel Travelling Through or Out of the Maximum-Controlled Areas to Mahidol University

Reference is made to the Declaration of an Emergency Situation, under Section No. 9 of the Emergency Decree on Public Administration in Emergency Situation B.E. 2548 (No. 17) to level up the enforcement of the maximum-controlled areas in 5 provinces covering Samut Sakhon, Rayong, Chanthaburi, Chon Buri and Trat and restrict the travel in and out of the areas.

In accordance with Mahidol University's previous announcements on the Closure of Mahidol University in Kanchanaburi Campus, Extension of Work from Home Measures and the Use of Online System for Academic Activities and Meetings dated the 31<sup>st</sup> December 2020, The Extension of the Closure of Mahidol University Salaya Campus, Work from Home Measures and the Use of Online System for Academic Activities and Meetings dated the 2<sup>nd</sup> January 2021, and Extension of Closure of Mahidol University Phyathai and Bangkok Noi Campuses, Work From Home Measures and the Use of Online System for Academic Activities and Meetings dated the 4<sup>th</sup> January 2021, Mahidol University's staff members were advised to avoid travelling and work from home. However, **if travelling to Mahidol University is a necessity due to the nature of work which cannot be conducted from home**, Mahidol University would advise as the followings:

1. Vice Presidents supervising divisions in the Office of the President and all campuses as well as heads of faculties/colleges/institutes are authorized to produce a certified travelling document for all staff members to travel and work temporarily at Mahidol University. 2. Academic and supporting staff travelling back and forth in the maximum controlled areas must present the university identification card and the certified travelling document at the inter-provincial check points upon request by the authorities.
  
3. Mahidol University staff members who are living and travelling through the maximum-controlled areas are to observe the measures to prevent the spread of the Coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19) released by the Department of Disease Control, Ministry of Public Health. All staff members of Mahidol University in those maximum-controlled areas are requested to cancel or postpone the travels, unless necessary.

This announcement enters into effect from this date on until the 1<sup>st</sup> February 2021.
