This event was organized by the newly formed association, Global Health Security Network (GHSN) and was held at the Suntec Convention & Exhibition Center in Singapore.


Mahidol University Students, Academic and International Services (MUSAIS) hosted a program titled "Dialogues on Youth Leadership & SDG Action"
