Mahidol University Welcomed Professors and Students from the University of Wisconsin at Madison



On 17th May 2022, **Assoc. Prof. Dr. Sarawut Tepanondh**, Dean, Faculty of Public Health, Mahidol University, welcomed ten students and two professors from the University of Wisconsin at Madison to a short course training titled "Community Health & Diseases in Thailand: Field Experience."

The training began with a special lecture by **Assoc. Prof. Dr. Chanuantong Thanasukarn**, Director of the Mahanakorn Health Promotion Center and a former Dean of the Faculty of Public Health. The Pharmaceutical Organization Representative Team provided the group with instructions on the topics of "Research and development of pharmaceutical products and medical supplies to meet the need of Thai society, COVID-19 Vaccine" and "Pharmaceutical Products and Medical Supply."

To learn about public health and COVID-19 management in Thailand, the students attended a lecture and conducted mock interviews with local residents at the Kanchanaburi Provincial Public Health Office, the Sai-Yok District Public Health Office, and the Ban Chong Ai Kang sub-district health promoting hospital. This event took place between 15th - 28th May 2022.

On 9th - 12th August 2022, two students from Mahidol University were chosen to represent Thailand as student representatives at the 2022 ASEAN-Korea Youth Summit (AKYS), which had as its theme "Act for Net-Zero, Move Toward a Better Future." 110 delegates in total convened via Metaverse and Zoom.
