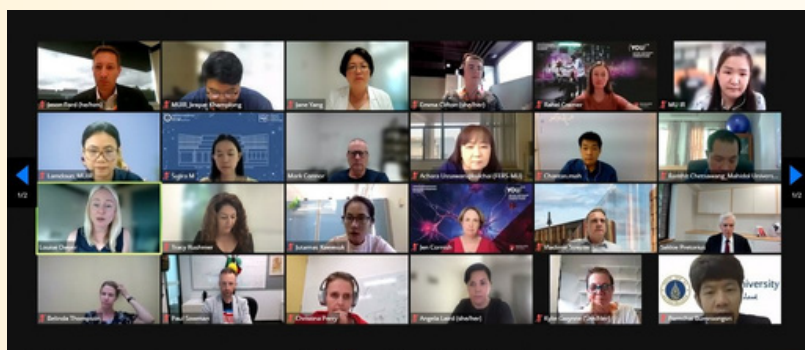
Mahidol University Participates in SATU Presidents' Forum 2022 General Assembly
