

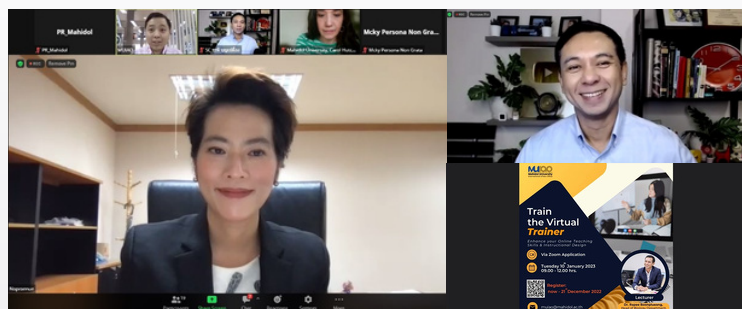


Mahidol University signing ceremony with APAIE on the hosting of APAIE 2023 Conference and Exhibition
