MoU Signing Ceremony between Mahidol University, The Centre National de la Recherche Scientifique and Kasetsart University

On 12th July 2023, **Assoc. Prof. Dr. Nopraenu Sajarax Dhirathiti**, Vice President for International Relations and Corporate Communication; **Dr. Antoine Petit**, CEO of The Centre National de la Recherche Scientifique (CNRS); and **Asst. Prof. Ratchot Chompunich**, Vice President for Student Affairs and Sustainable Development at Kasetsart University, participated in the signing of a Memorandum of Understanding for academic collaboration.

This occasion was honored by **H.E. Mr. Thierry Mathou**, Ambassador of France to Thailand, as well as delegates from Centre National de la Recherche Scientifique (CNRS), **Research Prof. Dr. Jetsumon Prachumsri**, Deputy Dean for Research at the Faculty of Tropical Medicine, and delegates from Kasetsart University, who jointly witnessed the ceremony. The objective of the agreement was to establish an international research lab focusing on health, ecological diseases, the environment, and related policies, specifically centered around biodiversity and its connections to human health.

After the session, **Prof. Serge Morand**, Mahidol University's Visiting Professor and Adjunct Professor at the Faculty of Tropical Medicine, Mahidol University, presented the outcomes of the International Research Laboratory (IRL) Health, Disease Ecology, Environment, and Policy (Health DEEP) project at Embassy of France in Bangkok.
