On 29th February 2024, **Prof. Banchong Mahaisavariya**, President of Mahidol University, along with **Assoc. Prof. Nopraenu Sajarax Dhirathiti**, Vice President for International Relations and Corporate Communication, extended a warm welcome to **H.E. Mr. Dhan Bahadur Oli**, Ambassador-Designate of Nepal to the Kingdom of Thailand, and **Mr. Prakash Adhikari**, Deputy Chief of Mission, Minister Counsellor, and Deputy Permanent Representative to UNESCAP.

During the meeting, collaborative discussions were held for future academic and research partnership, covering joint research, capacity building initiatives, as well as student and staff exchange programs between Mahidol University and educational institutions in Nepal.

Representing on behalf of RILCA is **Assoc. Prof. Dr. Morakot Meyer**, Director of the Research Institute for Languages and Cultures of Asia and on behalf of Yunus Emre Institute is **Dr. Ömer Altun**, Director of Kuala Lumpur Yunus Emre Institute.

On this occasion, **Assoc. Prof. Nopraenu Sajarax Dhirathiti**, Vice President for International Relations and Corporate Communication, along with the executives from the Research Institute for Languages and Cultures of Asia, Mahidol University, the representatives from the Embassy of the Republic of Turkey in Bangkok and the Yunus Emre Institute from the Republic of Turkey participated in witnessing the ceremony at Mahidol University, Salaya Campus.

This Memorandum of Understanding provides cooperation between RILCA and the Yunus Emre Institute in a wide range of areas such as staff and student exchange, joint research, curriculum development, training programs, and Turkish language courses exclusively for RILCA's students.

On 19th February 2024, **Assoc. Prof. Nopraenu Sajarax Dhirathiti**, Vice President for International Relations and Corporate Communication, along with **Prof. Dr. Chartchalerm Isarankura-Na-Ayudhya**, Dean, Faculty of Graduate Studies, engaged in discussions with **Dr. Anton Rahmadi**, Head of the Center for Higher Education Funding at the Ministry of Education, and **Prof. Dr. Ahmad Zainul Hamdi**, Director of the Higher Education Sector at the Ministry of Religious Affairs. Both ministries play a pivotal role in providing scholarships to educational professionals from the Republic of Indonesia in various fields through the Indonesia Endowment Fund for Education (LPDP).

Mahidol University has actively negotiated to secure a place in the list of internationally recognized educational institutions eligible for scholarship support from the Indonesian government. This initiative is a significant measure to bolster the implementation of Active Recruitment, scheduled to be organized by the Faculty of Graduate Studies and the International Relations Division, Mahidol University in early March 2024 in the Republic of Indonesia.

Following recent negotiations, the Ministry of Education and the Ministry of Religious Affairs of the Republic of Indonesia will once again acknowledge Mahidol University, allowing educational professionals and individuals from Indonesia interested in studying abroad to apply for Indonesian government scholarships to pursue studies at Mahidol University. This opportunity is particularly relevant to specialized fields such as Performing Arts, Pharmacy and Pharmacology, Anatomy and Physiology, Nursing, Life Sciences and Medicine, Hospitality and Leisure, Medicine, and Biomedical Engineering.
