A nurse from Ramathibodi School of Nursing, Faculty of Medicine Ramathibodi Hospital, Mahidol University, won the "Gold Medal" and the "Best of Nation" award in the "47th WorldSkills 2024" competition, held in Lyon, France.

On 10 th- 15 th September 2024, **Miss Ariyaporn** Limkamontip, Registered Nurse, the Division of Adult and Gerontological Nursing, Ramathibodi School of Nursing, Faculty of Medicine Ramathibodi Hospital, Mahidol University, participated in the WorldSkills Lyon 2024 competition and won Gold Medal and the Best of Nation award in the category of Health and Social Care. This competition was held in Lyon, France. Miss Ariyaporn Limkamontip was the first ever Thai youth from Ramathibodi School of Nursing to have won the Gold medal in the 47 WorldSkills 2024 competition, and also the only Thai participant to win a gold medal this year.

The purpose of this competition was to exhibit the incredible talent of youth representatives in various skill categories from all over the globe.
