On 18th – 19th July 2024, **Prof. Piyamitr Sritara**, MD, FRCP, Acting President of Mahidol University, together with **Assoc. Prof. Nopraenue Sajjarax Dhirathiti**, Ph.D., Acting Vice President for Global Partnerships and University Council, Mahidol University, participated in The 15th ASEAN University Network Rectors' Meeting, under the theme of "Shaping Our Region & The World: The Force of Universities in Sustainable Development". The meeting was organized by the ASEAN University Network Secretariat, with the purpose of serving as a platform to exchange opinions, perspectives, and roles of higher education institutions under the ASEAN University Network to enhance the cooperation in both regional and international levels, which is affiliated to the Sustainability Development Goals (SDGs), to meet up with the global challenges in the present world.
