

Announcement of Mahidol University Operational Guideline of Mahidol University in Accordance with the Government's Measures to Lift the Lockdown of the COVID-19

References are made to the release of the Thai government's provisions under Section 9 of the Emergency Decree on Public Administration in Emergency Situation B.E. 2548 (No. 10) dated the 12th June 2020 and the Announcement on the Measures to Lift the Lockdown of the COVID-19 by the Ministry of Higher Education, Science, Research and Innovation dated the 14th June 2020.

Mahidol University would like to announce on the new guideline for the university operation to be aligned with the above-mentioned government's announcements of the new provisions. Mahidol University's staff, both at the level of faculties/institutes/centers and at the Office of the President, are to resume the full-time office work from the 22nd June 2020 onwards. For those faculties/institutes/centers in which the resuming of the full-time office work cannot be implemented at this stage, they are encouraged to ensure that the efficiency and outputs of the units will not be affected. Faculties/institutes/centers can make use of spaces to provide teaching and learning as well as training sessions, provided that all units arrange the spaces and prepare personnel in accordance with the guidelines of the government's in preventing the re-emergence of the outbreak. These measures include, for example, the preliminary temperature screening, practice of social distancing, the sanitization of the premises and personal hygiene, mask wearing and the utilization of the mobile phone application to facilitate disease-control tracking. All in all, the measures observing the risk of contracting and spreading of the virus as well as the safety of students and personnel are of the utmost importance.
