

Announcement of Mahidol University

Guideline for Educational and Other Activities in Mahidol University During the Lockdown Lift of the COVID-19 Monitoring Measures

Reference is made to the release of the Announcement on the Measures to Lift the Lockdown of the COVID-19 in Higher Education Institutions and Other Agencies by the Ministry of Higher Education, Science, Research and Innovation dated the 12th August 2020.

Mahidol University would like to announce on the new guideline for the university's educational and other activities' operations in accordance with the measures suggested in the Announcement of MHESI above, with the strict observations of the disease control guidelines of the government. The new guideline includes:

- 1. All faculties/ institutes/ colleges are allowed to arrange both classroom teaching method or a hybrid online/on-site teaching, depending on the readiness and the nature of the programmes, starting from the 13th August 2020 onwards.
- 2. All faculties/institutes/colleges are still encouraged to avoid activities with a large crowd or those with direct or close interactions, such as, orientation activities and so on. This is to observe the government's measure to reduce the risk of the future outbreak.
- 3. The congregation ceremony shall be convened in accordance with measures to control and prevent the outbreak as announced by the Ministry of Public Health.
