

Announcement of Mahidol University

Guidelines for Students and University Personnel on Working from Home to Respond to the Coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19) Outbreak in Samut Sakhon Province

Reference is made to the announcement of the Ministry of Public Health regarding the Coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19) outbreak in Samut Sakhon province on 19th December 2020.

Mahidol University is announcing herewith measures for students, academic and supporting staff who are residing in Samut Sakhon province to refrain from traveling out of the province until the 3rd January 2021 or until announced otherwise by Samut Sakhon Province or the Ministry of Public Health. Additional details are as follows:

- 1. Students who are scheduled to sit in the final exam for the AY 1/2020, kindly contact programme directors or programme coordinators for further and more appropriate actions;
- 2. Vice Presidents supervising campuses and divisions under the Office of the President as well as Heads of Faculties/Institutes/Colleges are to assign workloads for academic/supporting staff who are residing in Samut Sakhon province during the Work from Home period. It is advised that the workloads are closely monitored to ensure the continuity of the management and services of Mahidol University; and
- 3. It is advised that students, academic and supporting staff are to observe social distancing measures, avoid large public gatherings, and act responsibly to oneself and towards others by

informing the Vice Presidents, Heads of faculties/institutes and colleges immediately if suspecting or having any signs or symptoms of the coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19).
