

Announcement of Mahidol University Guidelines for Event Postponement and Cancellation in Mahidol University due to the Coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19) Outbreak

Reference is made to Mahidol University's Announcement dated the 20th December 2020 on the Guideline for Organizing Activities in Mahidol University Following the Coronavirus 2019 (COVID-2019) Outbreak during Festive and Holiday Season and the Announcement of the Ministry of Higher Education, Science, Research and Innovation on the Precaution Measures to Monitor the Coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19) Outbreak (No.8) dated the 21st December 2020.

For health precaution and risk mitigation measures of the spread of the Coronavirus 2019, Mahidol University is announcing that:

- 1. All festive and unnecessary events with a large crowd are to be postponed or cancelled;
- 2. All academic events to be held in locations with reported infected cases of the Coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19) are to be postponed or cancelled and encouraged to use online systems instead.

Mahidol University would also like to encourage all academic and supporting staff as well as students to strictly follow the guideline of the Ministry of Public Health and observe social distancing, wear masks at all time, avoid crowded spaces and so on.
