

Announcement of Mahidol University on Travel Restriction to Mahidol University of Staff and Students Residing in the Maximum-Controlled Areas

Reference is made to the Declaration of an Emergency Situation, under Section No. 9 of the Emergency Decree on Public Administration in Emergency Situation B.E. 2548 (No. 17) dated the 6th January 2021 to level up the enforcement of the maximum-controlled areas in 5 provinces covering Samut Sakhon, Rayong, Chanthaburi, Chon Buri and Trat and restrict the travel in and out of the areas and the Announcement of Mahidol University on Document Certification for Mahidol University Personnel Travelling Through or Out of the Maximum-Controlled Areas to Mahidol University dated the 7th January 2021.

Mahidol University would like to further adjust measures to prevent the outbreak of the Coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19) and announce the followings:

- 1. All staff members residing in the 5 maximum controlled areas are advised <u>not to travel to all campuses of Mahidol University until the 31st January 2021</u>. Vice Presidents supervising campuses and divisions in the Office of the President as well as heads of faculties/colleges/institutes are to consider the workload of staff working from home and take into account the travel restrictions of those staff, members.
- 2. Heads of <u>faculties with affiliated hospitals are authorized to consider a combination of on-site operation and work-at-home among staff members</u> residing in the 5 maximum controlled areas as seen appropriate for the efficiency to provide public services and in accordance with announcements released by respective provincial authorities.

3. All the 1st year students residing in the 5 maximum controlled areas are advised not to travel to all campuses of Mahidol University until the 14th March 2021.

4. All the 2^{nd} – 6^{th} year students residing in the 5 maximum controlled areas are advised

not to travel to all campuses of Mahidol University until the 31st January 2021.

5. All staff members and students are advised to strictly follow the measures to prevent the outbreak of the Coronavirus 2019 (COVID-2019) released by the

Department of Disease Control, Ministry of Public Health.
