

Announcement of Mahidol University

On

The Prohibition of Mahidol University Premise Use in Salaya Campus under the Announcement on Adjusting the Measures to Prevent and Control the Outbreak of the Coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19) in Nakhon Pathom Province

Reference is made to the release of the Announcement on Adjusting the Measures to Prevent and Control the Outbreak of the Coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19) in Nakhon Pathom Province (No. 82/2564) dated the 31st August 2021 and the Announcement on the Re-opening of Mahidol University Premises under the State of Emergency Announcement dated the 31st August 2021.

In accordance with the consideration made by Nakhon Pathom Province regarding the situation of the outbreak of the Coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19) and the re-adjustment of certain measures to prevent and control the outbreak in the area, Mahidol University would like to inform all faculties/colleges and institutes as follows:

- 1) Mahidol University prohibits the use of the university premises in Salaya Campus for all activities with participants more than 25 people, except traditional ceremonies with prior arrangements and activities relating to healthcare services or campus security and maintenance. If holding any activity is considered a necessity, a formal request is to be submitted to the Province's Disease Control Committee for permission at Putthamonthon District Office at least 7 days in advance.
- 2) All heads of faculties/colleges/institutes and vice presidents responsible for units and divisions in the Office of the President are to extend the period for their staff to <u>fully work from home</u>, except those in healthcare- related services, campus security and maintenance units.

3) As regards academic activities, teaching and learning, examinations, research and

trainings, faculties/colleges/institutes are advised to hold those activities online and

to follow Mahidol University's Guideline for Undergraduate Teaching and Learning

(Academic Year 2564) dated the 23rd June 2021.

4) As for the use of the university's premises in other campuses as well as for certain

construction projects in Salaya Campus, faculties/colleges/institutes are to follow the

measures suggested in the Announcement on the Re-opening of Mahidol University

Premises under the State of Emergency Announcement dated the 31st August 2021

This announcement enters into effect from the 3rd September 2021 onwards until

further notice.
