## Announcement of Mahidol University

Scholarship for Students Affected by the Coronavirus 2019 Pandemic - Academic Year 2019

---

As the Coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19) pandemic is affecting many countries and territories including Thailand, not only our health has been threatened but also the economic systems around the world. Community within Mahidol University (students, faculty members, and supporting staff) has no exemption. Accordingly, Mahidol University has been aware of the situation and is announcing the guidelines to aid and relieve affected students as follows:

### **Type of scholarship**

Scholarship for undergraduate students who have been affected in Semester 2 of the Academic Year 2019 - 600 scholarships (5,000 Baht per scholarship)

### **Application criteria**

1. The applicants must be undergraduate students who are currently enrolled at Mahidol University.
2. The applicants must be those who have been affected by the COVID - 19, such as, the students who have been contracted the COVID - 19, listed in high-risk / low-risk contracting cases in reference to the Announcement of Mahidol University, or encountered financial impact from the COVID - 19 pandemic.
3. The applicants must be in good standing, have never been imposed disciplinary penalty according to the University's rules and regulations and strictly followed the Announcement of Mahidol University on "Safety and Precaution Measures Regarding the COVID-19 for Students".
4. The applicants must have been impacted in Semester 2, Academic Year 2019.

## Required documents

1. A completed application form (The application can be downloaded from <https://op.mahidol.ac.th/sa/scholarship-covid19>)
2. A copy of the National Identification Card (ID card)
3. A copy of the Student Identification Card (Student ID card)
4. A copy of the first page of bankbook (The account name and the applicant name must be the same.)
5. One of the evidences below to indicate that the applicant is affected from the COVID-19 pandemic:
  - 5.1 Medical certificate (in case that you or your family members were found to have been contracted the COVID-19)
  - 5.2 Proof of your quarantine (in case that you are listed as high-risk or low-risk contracting case in accordance with the Announcement of Mahidol University)
  - 5.3 Proof of job suspension or lay-off (in case that you have a part-time job)
  - 5.4 Proof of your parents' job suspension or lay-off to show the economic impact
  - 5.5 If you do not have any evidences above, please provide the explanation, no more than one A4 paper in length, about the COVID-19 impact on you or your family, attached with a letter or an email from your advisor, OR any other proofs that show the economic impact you have been facing.
