Announcement of Mahidol University Criteria and Procedures for Student Health Services, 2020

The criteria and procedures for student health services have been improved in order to better facilitate the university's students.

By virtue of Section 34 of the Mahidol University Act B. E. 2550 (2007), Clause 6 (1) of the Announcement of Mahidol University on Student Affairs Funding Accounts Management, B.E. 2553 (2010), the President issues the Announcement as follows:

Clause 1. The following shall be cancelled:

- 1.1 Announcement of Mahidol University on Criteria and Procedures for Student Health Services, B.E. 2561 (2018)
- 1.2 Announcement of Mahidol University on Criteria and Procedures for Student Health Services (issue 2), B.E. 2562 (2019)

Clause 2. This Announcement applies to students whose student codes begin with 63xxxxx, who have enrolled since the 2020 academic year.

Students who attended Mahidol University before the 2020 academic year shall follow the Announcement of Mahidol University on Criteria and Procedures for Student Health Services, 2018 and its additions until graduation.

Clause 3. Pursuant to this Announcement,

"The University" means Mahidol University;

"Students" means students of all nationalities of the University including students of joint institutes, in accordance with the University's regulations on joint institutes, students of the co-teaching institutes, exchange students, and visiting students;

"Tuition Fee" means a tuition fee including health care service cost in the semester of the program.

"Health services" means treatments for symptoms or diseases, therapies, or other methods to keep the body or mind in a normal state; "Dental services" means oral health treatment services, therapies, or other methods to maintain oral health in a normal state;

"Expenses" means the money that healthcare providers charge for medicines, blood, blood components or substitutes, intravenous medicine or nutrients, oxygen, etc. similarly used in the treatment of diseases. This also includes medical service expenses and disease analysis fees. This does not include pregnancy-related fees such as pregnancy analysis, treatment fees for chronic diseases that students have had before attending the university, special expenses such as body organs and other named services for compensation or beauty purposes;

"Student healthcare units" means the University's student healthcare units;

"Mahidol University- affiliated healthcare units" means Siriraj Hospital, Ramathibodi Hospital, Hospital for Tropical Diseases, Golden Jubilee Medical Center, Dental Hospital of the Faculty of Dentistry, Maha Chakri Sirindhorn Dental Hospital of the Faculty of Dentistry, Ramathibodi Chakri Naruebodindra Hospital, Faculty of Medicine Ramathibodi Hospital, and Mahidol Bamrungrak Medical Center.

"Network healthcare units" means non-university affiliated organizations healthcare providers that have an agreement or coordination the Mahidol University to provide health services to students;

"Fund" means the Student Affairs Fund in accordance with the Announcement of Mahidol University on Student Affairs Funding Accounts Management.

Clause 4. Students' rights to receive health and dental services:

Students will be eligible for health and dental services in accordance with this Announcement only if the semester's tuition fee, in which the healthcare fee is included, is paid. The rights shall be valid until the starting date of the next semester and/or until the end of the student's student status. The right is also valid for students who are registered to maintain their student status and have its fee paid completely.

If the course requires more than two semesters in each academic year, students need to pay a full tuition fee as required by the University in order to cover the whole academic year and to gain the right to health and dental services.

Students who are exempt from tuition fees will be eligible for health and dental services in accordance with this Announcement under the following conditions:

(1) The students shall receive a full scholarship for tuition fee which covers health services.

(2) The students shall receive partial scholarship for tuition fee which does not cover health services, and they shall pay the difference.

Clause 5. Actions on the right to access health and dental services

5.1 Students of Thai nationality are required to register for receiving their basic medical benefits in accordance with their rights namely the rights to national health insurance, the Comptroller General's Department, state enterprises, or social security, as the case may be.

The reimbursement of medical expenses under the students' medical welfare rights stated in paragraph one is in accordance with the University's criteria and procedures as seen in the Annex 1 attached in this Announcement.

5.2 Students of non-Thai nationality shall be provided with health insurance by their affiliates or the University, which must at least cover the following:

5.2.1 Inpatient health insurance (IPD)

- Expenses for room and meal per day, at least 31 days per policy year
- (2) Expenses for intensive care unit stay (ICU), at least 7 days per policy year
- (3) Other medical expenses such as ambulance fee
- (4) Surgical expenses
- (5) Doctor visit fee, once per day, at least 30 days per policy year
- (6) Emergency medical expenses in case of accident
- (7) Medical consultation fee
- 5.2.2 Outpatient health insurance (OPD), once per day, at least

30 times per policy year

Clause 6. In order to ensure their medical welfare rights before receiving health and dental services, Thai students are required to present their Thai national ID card and their student ID card, while students of non-Thai nationality are required to present their passport or a copy of their passport and their student ID card to the student healthcare unit, the Mahidol University-affiliated healthcare unit, or the network healthcare unit.

Clause 7. Students can receive health services at the designated medical facilities as follows:

7.1 Students can receive health services during regular office hours at the student healthcare units of their faculties or nearby faculties, Mahidol University-affiliated healthcare units, or network healthcare units as listed in the Annex 2.

7.2 Students can receive out-of-hours health services at the Mahidol University-affiliated healthcare units in accordance with the units' criteria and time.

7.3 In case of an emergency illness or an accident, students shall receive health services at student healthcare units and other healthcare units respectively as follows:

7.3.1 The nearest student healthcare unit

7.3.2 A Mahidol University-affiliated healthcare unit or a network

healthcare unit

7.3.3 Other healthcare units; students may claim for reimbursement

according to their rights.

Clause 8. Students can receive dental services at Mahidol University-affiliated healthcare units as the following details:

8.1 Students of Thai nationality who hold the basic rights to the services at Mahidol University-affiliated healthcare units, namely the rights to national health insurance, the Comptroller General's Department, state enterprises, or social security, shall receive healthcare services according to their basic rights.

8.2 Students of Thai nationality who do not hold the basic rights to the Mahidol University-affiliated healthcare units and students of non-Thai nationality can receive dental fee reimbursement within the amount of 500 baht per academic year, which is included in the fund stated in number 9.

Clause 9. The University shall support the expenses of health and dental services by means of the fund within the amount of 30,000 baht per person per academic year under the following conditions:

9.1 The expenses of health and dental services which students receive exceeds their medical welfare rights stated in number 5 but does not exceed the Comptroller General's Department's limit, due to the doctor's opinion on medical necessity or the prescribing of non-essential drugs which are not included in the National List of Essential Medicine as stated in Annex 3 of this Announcement.

9.2 For students who are receiving health services while they are still in the process of registering for medical welfare rights, and thus they are ineligible for reimbursement, the support only covers expenses from Mahidol University-affiliated healthcare units. It does not cover special clinic services.

9.3 For students who have emergency illness and need urgent transport to a healthcare unit when the university is unable to provide transportation, the support of transportation in this case is within 500 baht per one incident.

9.4 For students who have emergency illness and need to be delivered urgently by ambulance, the support covers only the ambulance to Mahidol University-affiliated healthcare units and network healthcare units.

9.5 Students of Thai nationality who have no basic rights to the Mahidol University-affiliated healthcare units and students of non-Thai nationality can claim dental service expenses in the amount of 500 baht per academic year.

The University's expense support within the amount of money stated in paragraph one to each case is under the consideration of Vice President authorized by the President. The support covers only the case receiving health services in the following healthcare units:

(1) Mahidol University-affiliated healthcare units

(2) Network healthcare units which include:

(2.1) In Salaya area: Phutthamonthon Hospital or other healthcare units coordinated with the University

(2.2) Around Kanchanaburi Campus: Sai Yok Hospital or Phaholpol Payuhasena Hospital

(2.3) Around Amnat Charoen Campus Establishment Project: Amnat Charoen Hospital

(2.4) Around Nakhon Sawan Campus Establishment Project: Khao Thong Health Promoting Hospital or Phayuha Khiri Hospital or Sawanpracharak Hospital

Clause 10. The channels where students can ask for drawdown from the fund in accordance with number 9 are as follows:

10.1 Pre-college students and undergraduate students contact the Division of Student Affairs, Mahidol University.

10.2 Graduate students contact the Graduate School, Mahidol University.

Clause 11. Once the students no longer hold student status in accordance with the university regulations, the University will send a list of such students to the National Health Security Office (NHSO) in order to return the students' basic rights to the healthcare units that students originally had before enrolling in the University. The students' basic rights are located according to their house registration. Clause 12. Any payment stipulated in student health services, in addition to the students' medical welfare rights specified in this Announcement, shall be drawn from the Student Affairs Fund in accordance with the Announcement of Mahidol University on Student Affairs Funding Accounts Management. The payment must be approved by the President or Vice President authorized by the President.

Clause 13. Any cases that fail to comply with this Announcement shall be put in the President's consideration, and the President's judgment is final.

This Announcement shall be effective from the 2020 academic year onwards.
